Bamburgh Castle – Project: Pantry Roof Replacement

Bamburgh Castle spans 9 acres of land high above the Northumberland coastline.

C&D Access were tasked to assist with the repair work to the roof deck and coverings at the Captain's Lodgings, making it safe and bringing the building roof back into sustainable use, along with re-pointing of stonework, all of which to be completed by means of rope access.

The proposed work was to replace the existing roof deck with a new roof comprising of suspended timber joints supported by angle irons with plywood deck.

The restoration project was carried out by a three man team over an 8 day period, and was carried out by a mixture of vertical ascension, descending and aid climbing.
